Levels of Accountability

When students engage in behaviors that do not exhibit Viking PRIDE, there are a series of consequences they could receive, which may result in a Minor Incident Report (MIR).

Level 1: A general reminder will be given to all.

Level 2: An individual reminder will be given if the behavior continues.

Level 3: Time Out I: The student will move to another area in the room. The teacher may choose to write a MIR.

Level 4: Time Out II: The teacher will write a MIR. The student will be sent to another teacher's classroom, where the student will complete an assignments. Parents WILL be notified.

Level 5: An office referral could be written. The student may be sent to the office. Administrator will notify parents, determine consequence, and update the teacher.

Minor Incident Report (MIR) vs Office Referrals

- **MIRs and Office Referrals are NOT the same**
- **MIRs are handled by the teacher, and teacher contacts home.**
- **Official referrals are handled by an administrator who contacts home and administers the appropriate consequence.**

Minor Incident Report (MIR) Policy

3 MIRS: administrative conference and lunch detention

4 MIRS: second lunch detention

5 MIRS: after school detention

6 MIRS and higher: Could result in an In-School Intervention (ISI)

This policy resets each quarter

Late to Class Policy

1st Time Late: Verbal Warning

2nd Time Late: Communication Home

3rd Time Late: Communication Home/MIR

4th Time Late: An office referral and after school detention assigned

This policy resets each quarter
