#### 2024-2025 High School Course Registration Opens Dec. 18

Course registration for the 2024-2025 school year will open for **current 8-11 grade students at 8:00 a.m. Monday, Dec. 18, 2023, and run through 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 16, 2024.** The high school course registration process is completed by students each year online in HCPSS Connect Synergy. Schedule modifications are made in the late winter/early spring, and final student schedules, including class periods and teachers, are available in late August.

- $\rightarrow$  Dec. 18, 2023: Registration opens
- $\rightarrow$  Jan. 16, 2024: Registration closes
- $\rightarrow$  January-February 2024: Students meet with school counselors to review course requests
- $\rightarrow$  Spring 2024: Students/families view scheduled courses for 2024-2025 school year
- $\rightarrow$  August 2024: Prior to start of school year, complete student schedules are available

#### Reservoir HS Dance Placement Auditions

Dance Placement Auditions will be held in the dance studio on Friday, Jan. 12th from 4:30-6:30. Students should wear dance attire (leotard, tank top or shirt & leggings) and secure hair away from face. Upon arrival, students will complete an audition form, receive a number sticker and enter the studio to stretch. The audition process is broken down into three rounds: across the floor, modern combination, jazz combination. Students will be placed in the most appropriate class for their level of tech after each round. Some students will not need to stay for the entire process. Those with more dance experience should expect to remain for all three rounds which usually end between 6:15-6:30. All students may registration for Dance 1 without participating in the audition process. Any students planning on attending auditions should put Dance 1 on their schedule, any corrections to incoming freshman schedules will be made through RHS Student Services.
