# Please perform daily health checks and keep sick children at home:

- Temperature of 100 degrees or higher
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore Throat
- Body Aches
- Abdominal Cramps
- Diarrhea
- Nausea/Vomiting

If your child requires medication (prescription or over the counter) during the 2024-2025 school year, your child's health care provider must complete a medication form and/or an Epi-Pen Care form. All prescribed medications must be in properly labeled containers that include the following information:

- Student name
- Medication name

- Dose to be given
- Time & Frequency of medication
- Prescriber's name & signature
- · Date of medication order

Pharmacy labels will usually contain this information. Over-the-counter medications should be in new, unopened containers labeled with the student's name.

# Complete and/or Renew Your FARMs Application by October 31

HCPSS participates in the Free and Reduced-price Meals (FARMs) program. Qualification

<u>Links to an external site.</u> is based on family size and income, and enrollment is confidential.

Participation in FARMs qualifies students for a wide range of opportunities and resources beyond breakfast and lunch, including free college applications, free

or reduced JumpStart tuition, discounted internet through the Comcast Internet Essentials program, and more.

# Families must submit a new application every school year by Oct.

**31.** During the first 30 school days, students with FARMs eligibility from the prior school year will continue to receive benefits. Any student whose family has not filled out an application by the 30th school day will have their status changed to full pay until a new application is received.

Parents/guardians are highly encouraged to fill out the applications as soon as possible. It is very important that applications are filled out accurately and completely. Families can:

- Apply by mail: Paper applications can be picked up in the Food and Nutrition Service Office (5451 Beaverkill Rd, Columbia, MD 21044).

#### REMINDERS

Dear HMS Families,

Thank you for your patience as we work through our dismissal/carpool procedures. We are working with Hammond Elementary to devise the best possible plan for our shared parking lot.

Any drivers in the car loop are expected to abide by the procedures communicated by the school. Our staff work incredibly hard each day to stand on duty. Please remember to smile at them, wave a friendly hello, or thank them for their hard work. Whether rain or shine (or 100+ degree temperatures), they ensure students are safe.

### Please review important updates to carloop information below:

 We have kindly requested HES families to arrive after 3:30 pm, once our dismissal process is concluded. The early arrival of parked cars is disrupting the efficiency of our dismissal and the ability of our middle school buses to access their pick-up locations.

- Car riders and walkers will exit Hammond Middle School between 3:15 pm and 3:20 pm daily.
- Vehicles entering the school campus should queue <u>along the RIGHT side</u> of the school entrance driveway. <u>Vehicles cannot be driven or stopped on the LEFT of the roadway</u> where they are impeding oncoming traffic. <u>When the line reaches Graeloch Road, vehicles should queue again along the right side of the roadway towards Helmart Drive. It's imperative to keep the intersection of <u>Aladdin Drive and Graeloch Road clear of vehicles</u> so that school buses and emergency vehicles can access our school. Proceed accordingly once you enter the school property and the bus loop and car loop split.
  </u>
- Please be aware of school buses entering the school campus on the left and then needing to turn right into the bus loop.

#### A few reminders:

- Be aware of your surroundings when waiting in the car loop, and be ready to follow the directions of staff on duty.
- · Act with civility at all times.

The email should include the student's name, the parent's name, the date(s) or period(s) (if absence is a partial day) of the absence, and the reason for the absence. The email must be received within 5 days of the absence. Requests for changes to attendance submitted after the 5 day deadline may not be honored. Please Note: Absences are unexcused until an email or note is received.
